- Class 3 Intro Hunter Trial - fence height not exceeding 2'9"
Open to Junior & Senior riders on horses or ponies*
First Prize - £50
- Class 4 Intro Pairs – fence height up to 2' 9"
Open to Junior & Senior riders on horses or ponies*
First Prize - £50
- Class 5 Open Pre Novice – fence height not exceeding 3ft 3ins
Open to Junior & Senior riders on horses or ponies*
First Prize - £100

Rosettes to 6th place and Cash to 1st place (in the event of a tie the money will be divided)

Entry costs are £20 per person or £30 per pair. Entries close three days before the event. Late entries incur a £3.00 surcharge per horse (received after closure date at the discretion of the organizer). To qualify for the BRC please see next paragraph.

Gloucester Lodge is on the A193, which is the coast road between Blyth and Seaton Sluice. The car park is approx 200 meters south of the farm on the west side of the road and will be well sign posted.

THERE WILL BE A NO RIGHT TURN TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLAN IN OPERATION. Drivers are advised to approach via Seaton Delaval – Seaton Sluice – direction to the course.

Competitors and visiting guests must obey parking rules via the parking attendant on the day, failure to do so may result in the competitor being eliminated and all entries forfeited.

- This competition will be run under BE rules and
- All horses must be of four years and over
- All horses must be accompanied by their passport
- Riders must wear secured hard hats of current British Standard, at all times when mounted.
- Body protectors are advised to be worn when competing
- The organisers accept no liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, persons, property or spectators.
- Vehicles and trailers are parked at the owners risk
- Dogs are not encouraged but should be kept under control and on leads at all times
- Any complaint must be lodged in writing with a deposit of £30 (returnable if upheld) within 30 minutes of the results going up. The decision of the chief steward will be final.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any horse, pony or rider they feel is not fit enough to compete
- Horses and ponies should not be left unattended at any time
- The organisers intend to run the event on time. Competitors should report to the start / collecting ring at least 5 minutes before they are due to start. Late arrivals will be eliminated unless they can be fitted in without disrupting the organisation of the event
- Over use of whips & spurs will not be tolerated and will lead to elimination
- The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure that the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey instructions of the stewards.
