Directions

Gloucester Lodge is on the A193, which is the coast road between Blyth and Seaton Sluice. The car park is approx 200 meters south of the farm on the west side of the road and will be well sign posted.

Rules

This competition will be run under BE rules and

- All horses must be of four years and over
- All horses must be accompanied by their passport
- Riders must wear secured hard hats of current British Standard, at all times when mounted.
- Riders using 2 point air jackets must provide their own number and bib
- Body protectors are advised to be worn when competing
- The organisers accept no liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, persons, property or spectators.
- Slower horses must give way to faster competitors
- Vehicles and trailers are parked at the owners risk
- Dogs are not encouraged but should be kept under control and on leads at all times
- Any complaint must be lodged in writing with a deposit of £30 (returnable if upheld) within 30 minutes of the results going up. The decision of the chief steward will be final.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any horse, pony or rider they feel is not fit enough to compete
- Horses and ponies should not be left unattended at any time
- The organisers intend to run the event on time. Competitors should report to the collecting ring at least 5 minutes before they are due to start. Late arrivals will be eliminated unless they can be fitted in without disrupting the organisation of the event
- Over use of whips & spurs will not be tolerated and will lead to elimination
- The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure that the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey instructions of the stewards.
- Photographs will be taken at this event and published on the internet for purchase. By entering this event you give permission this includes under 18's
- **This event runs on optimum time. As per BE rules timing clocks are not permitted anyone seen wearing a timing device capable of being stopped or started will be eliminated. Anyone seen to be helping or giving outside assistance to a competitor will result in the competitor's elimination**
