- Class 3.** HORSE & PONY - INTERMEDIATE JUMPING – 2'6" – 2'9"
- Class 4.** HORSE & PONY - OPEN – 2'9" - 3'0"
- Class 5.** HORSE & PONY - SUPER OPEN – 3'0" – 3'3"

Fun Classes: Follow on

- Class 6.** Accumulator
- Class 7.** One horse - two riders
- Class 8.** Pairs
- Class 9.** Orange Juice Stakes

All classes will only go ahead if there are sufficient entries.

Directions

Gloucester Lodge is on the A193, which is the coast road between Blyth and Seaton Sluice. The car park is approx 200 meters south of the farm on the west side of the road and will be well sign posted.

THERE WILL BE A NO RIGHT TURN TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLAN IN OPERATION. Drivers are advised to approach via Seaton Delaval – Seaton Sluice – direction to the course.

Competitors and visiting guests must obey parking rules via the parking attendant on the day, failure to do so may result in the competitor being eliminated and all entries forfeited.

Conditions of Entry

- The rules of the competition will be displayed in the caravan on the day of the competition.
- All horses must be four years and over
- Competitors must wear Riding Hats of current standard properly fastened at all times when mounted on the show field. Proper riding footwear must be worn when riding.
- All horses must be accompanied by their passport
- The organizers accept no liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, persons, property or spectators.
- Vehicles and trailers are parked at the owners risk
- Dogs should be kept under control and on leads at all times
- Any complaint must be lodged in writing with a deposit of £25 (returnable if upheld) within 30 minutes of the results going up. The decision of the chief steward will be final.
- The organizers reserve the right to refuse entry to any horse, pony or rider they feel is not fit enough to compete
- Horses and ponies should not be left unattended at any time
- The organizers intend to run the event on time. Late arrivals will be eliminated unless they can be fitted in without disrupting the organization of the event
- The organizers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure that the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey instructions of the stewards.
- The cross country course will be closed on the day of the event anyone found using it without prior permission will be asked to leave and all entry fees forfeited.
