### Junior & Senior Points Competition 2011 Sponsored by Equine Answers

A brilliant first prize for the highest senior and junior, each will be £50 cash training bursary, a day's free use of the GLF cross country course, embroidered fleece cooler rug and various horse and rider goodies, courtesy of Gloucester Lodge Farm and Equine Answers

Special Points Rosettes will be awarded to sixth place.

These are horse/pony and rider competitions and will be held over seven competitions as follows\*

Hunter Trial – 22 April 2011

Hunter Trial – 8 May 2011

One Day Event – 19 June 2011

Dressage – 25 June 2011

Show Jumping – 25 June 2011

Show Cross – 11 Sept 2011

Hunter Trial – 9 Oct 2011

Points will be awarded as follows

<b>1st.</b>	6 points
<b>2nd.</b>	5 points
<b>3rd.</b>	4 points
<b>4th.</b>	3 points
<b>5th.</b>	2 points
<b>6th.</b>	1 point

A bonus of 6 points will be given to the horse and rider who competes at all seven events. Points can only be awarded per horse and rider for one event per competition, if the horse and rider compete in two classes in the same event / day then the highest points from one class will count. There is no limit to the number of horses a rider can compete with but points cannot be transferred to another rider or horse.

In the case of a tie then the horse and rider who has completed the XC phases nearest the optimum time on the most occasions will win. However if there is still a tie we will then look at Dressage marks or show jumping score at the Show Cross or Show Jumping events. Only then will we split the prize equally between the winners. Junior's competing in open classes will receive points according to their place in the class. Juniors must be 16 or under on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2011.

\*In the event of a cancellation the number of competitions will be reduced accordingly the event will be run in the 2011 season
