Clinic heights are: 60 cms Complete Novice 60/80 Intermediate 80/90 Confident

Classes may be mixed ability, the jumps are located so riders can jump different heights and there is plenty of time to spend with everyone

- All horses must be of four years and over
- No videos can be taken at any time whilst the training is in operation either by riders or spectators, unless agreed in advance by the trainer
- Riders must wear secured hard hats of current British Standard, at all times when mounted.
- Body protectors are compulsory when jumping
- The organisers accept no liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, persons, property or spectators.
- Vehicles and trailers are parked at the owners risk
- Dogs should be kept under control and on short leads at all times
- Riders are responsible for ensuring their horse is fit enough to attend but the organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any horse, pony or rider they feel is not fit enough to attend. No refund will be made for these circumstances
- Horses and ponies should not be left unattended at any time
- The organisers intend to run the event on time. Trainees should be tacked up and ready to ride at least 10 minutes before they are due to start. Late arrivals will not be included unless they can be fitted in without disrupting the rest of the training. You will need to warm up and be ready to jump
- Over use of whips will not be tolerated and will lead to exclusion
- The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure that the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey instructions of the trainers at all times.
- Everyone attending this event must be respectful to each other. Use of inappropriate language, intimidation or unsporting behaviour by a competitor or representative may result in a competitor being asked to leave and all money paid forfeited.
